Admission in first year of Bachelor of Education course is based on Entrance exam conducted by B.R.A. Bihar University, Muzaffarpur/other competent body.

### ELIGIBILITY FOR BACHELOR OF EDUCATION

- ✦ At least 50% marks in Bachelor's degree and/or Master's Degree in Sciences/Social Sciences/Humanity, Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% or equivalent.
- ✦ Candidates having higher degree are also eligible.

## DIPLOMA IN ELEMENTARY EDUCATION COURSE (D. EL. ED.) - 2 Year, Full Time

Admission in Diploma in Elementary Education course is based on:  
Entrance exam conducted by SKCE/Board/other competent body.

### ELIGIBILITY FOR DIPLOMA IN ELEMENTARY EDUCATION:

#### Educational Qualification:

- ✚ Candidate should have passed Std. 10+2<sup>th</sup> or equivalent exam with an aggregate of 50% or above.
- ✚ Candidates having higher degree are also eligible.

Age Limit: Candidates should be 17-34 years of age as on 1<sup>st</sup> January of the academic year.

### INTAKE

Diploma in elementary education (D.El.Ed.) - 100

### RELAXATION

- ✚ Marks 5% relaxation in marks for candidates of Reserved/PH category.
- Age Limit:** Relaxation of 5 years in upper age limit for candidates of SC/ST/PH category.

- ✚ Relaxation of 2 years in upper age limit for woman candidates other than SC/ST/PH category

# ANTI-RAGGING

## What Is Ragging?

As defined by the Honourable Supreme Court of India, Ragging is ---“ Any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written, or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological or physical harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.”



## CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

In pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, the University Grants Commission has framed “UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions, 2009” which were notified on 4th July, 2009 in the Gazette of India. These regulations are mandatory for all Universities/Institutions. The UGC has made it mandatory for all students/parents to submit anti ragging related affidavits to the institutions at the time of admission.

## ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE

Ragging within or outside the educational institution is prohibited.

The College has an Anti-Ragging Committee to look into the matters and complaints related to ragging. It is in the light of the Regulations framed in 2009 by the UGC for curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational Institutions and amended in 2013 and 2016 that the Anti Ragging Committee decides upon the action to be taken after charges are proved against those involved in ragging.

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the Institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging shall be suspended, expelled or rusticated from the institution and shall also be liable to fine. The punishment includes rigorous imprisonment, cancellation of admission, suspension from attending classes, withholding/ withdrawing fellowships/ scholarships and other financial benefits, withholding or cancelling the results.

In addition, in case of every single incident of ragging, a First Information Report (FIR) will be filed with the local police authorities. The possible punishment includes rigorous imprisonment (in compliance with the order of Supreme Court of India).

# Rules & Regulations

1. Students are expected to come to college in proper College Uniform.
2. 80% attendance in theory and 90% attendance in practical is mandatory.
3. It is compulsory to appear in sessional, practical and internal examinations.
4. It is mandatory to maintain discipline in and out of the College campus.
5. Use of mobile phones by students within the campus is strictly prohibited.
6. All information related to Academic, payment of fees, curricular and extracurricular activities will be displayed on the college Notice-Board. Students are advised to see the Notice-Board daily.
7. Respect for others begets respect for self. Students are expected to respect all teachers, staff and seniors.
8. Any damage to college property will lead to severe punishment – monetary, expulsive or/and penal.
9. Smoking, drug addiction, narcotics, consumption of alcoholic drinks, chewing of tobacco, spitting, writing on walls and any other evil habits are strictly prohibited in the premises including hostels.
10. All dues should compulsorily be paid before the filling of Registration/examination forms.
11. In all matters pertaining to discipline, directives of the Principal/HOD shall be binding and final.



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
